## Admissions Process

Based on the student's IEP, a referral is made by the school to P2E with the student/family completing an admission packet.

## Scheduling

Scheduling is offered in blocks of time determined by the school and space availability. Blocks are based on time increments for up to two and four hours. Students are transported to and from the program by the school.

## Funding Sources

Funding sources are determined through a Memorandum of Understanding and established upon admission approval. Funding comes from either Arkansas Rehabilitation Services or the school.
